JOB SUMMARY:

Plan, organize and supervise all functions of the School's facilities including the areas of Safety, Electrical, Ventilation ,Cooling and Fire alarm Systems. Ensure Technical Team members are efficient and effective through proper Supervision.

KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- Ensure proper Operations and maintenance of the School's electrical infrastructure, ventilation, cooling and fire alarm systems including major and minor repair works.
- Plan, Schedule, implement and monitor ongoing planned, preventive, emergency and deferred maintenance of all electrical, ventilation, cooling and fire alarm systems.

- Maintain an Asset register for all Electrical, Ventilation, Cooling and Fire alarm Systems. Ensure information is up to date and readily available.
- Periodically audit, carry out condition and adequacy assessments of installations and equipment and make recommendations for upgrades and replacements.
- Ensure an efficient and effective work order system for repairs including the response and coordination of all maintenance requests and needs.
- Maintain an inventory control system and purchase supplies, parts, materials and equipment through the established bid or price quote process that follows School regulations.
- Establish and implement an effective summer and non-School day program of specialized maintenance and repairs.
- Carryout and monitor progress of all projects outlined in the annual budget.
- Supervise, direct, assign and evaluate the daily work and performance of assigned staff. Train employees in work procedures, standards and safety practices.
